



TOURNAMENT RULES

WROCŁAW HANDBALL CUP

I. Organizer:

1. Organizer of the tournament are international sports agency **"Around the Sport"** & professional handball club **"WKS Śląsk Wrocław"**.
2. The sport coordinator of the Tournament is **Grzegorz Kunka** phone number +48 605 550 100.

II. Place & period:

The competition will take place in 7-10 sports halls with permanent handball infrastructure in Wrocław on August 24-28, 2021.

The final matches will be played at the "Orbita" sports and entertainment hall in Wrocław.

III. Participation:

1. Team leader. Each team must be accompanied by an adult guardian (over 18 years of age). This person's name, address and date of birth must be clearly stated on the team registration form. This person will be considered the team minder and will be responsible for the behavior of their players on and off the pitch. This person will also be responsible for the behavior of the players within the sports complex and other facilities available to the group
2. The responsibility of each team is to provide proper insurance for own team. It is also the responsibility of the team leader to check that all players have passed the appropriate tests and have no health contraindications for the game, and in the case of players minors obtained permission to participate from their parents or legal guardians.
3. Before each match, the Team Leader must complete the match report. After the match, the team leader signs the protocol confirming the final result and the individual statistics of the players.
4. The player may only compete in one team.
5. The identity of the players may only be checked before the match at the request of the opposite team, the organizer or the referees. Each player is then obliged to come to the table with his photo ID (ID card, passport, student card etc.). In the absence of a document confirming the identity and no photo of the player on the subpage of his team, the player is not allowed to play.
6. Teams are required to play in the handball jersey with numbers on their shirts.
In the absence of the t-shirts with numbers, the team is obliged to play in the tags provided by the organizer. In a situation where both teams have similar t-shirt colors, the team marked "host" in the match protocols plays in the special color tags.

IV. Age categories:

1. **G10/U10** – boys and girls born on / after 01.01.2011. – Combined category
2. **G12** - girls born on / after 01.01.2009.
3. **U12** - boys born on / after 01.01.2009.
4. **G14** - girls born on / after 01.01.2007.
5. **U14** - boys born on / after 01.01.2007.
6. **G16** - girls born on / after 01.01.2005.
7. **U16** - boys born on / after 01.01.2005.
8. **G18** - girls born on / after 01.01.2003.
9. **U18** - boys born on / after 01.01.2003.

V. The team:

1. The team may consist of a maximum of 16 players.
2. During the match, 7 players from each team may be on the field with the exception of the U10 / G10 category. The other players should seat on the bench.
3. The teams in category U10 / G10 may be mixed (Boys & Girls in one team).

VI. Game rules:

1. All matches will be played in accordance with the handball rules laid down by the Polish Handball Federation approved by the IHF, except as amended herein regulations by the organizer:

2. The number of points obtained will determine the order in the table during the group stage.
The scoring system is as follows: 2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a defeat. In the event that two or more teams finish the game with an equal number of points, the order in the table is decided in the following order:

- More points awarded in matches between the teams concerned;
- Better goal difference in all group matches;
- More goals scored in all group matches;

VII. Disciplinary issues:

1. A player who receives a red and a blue card in the match shall pause at least in the next match of the team. Behavior inconsistent with the spirit of sport during the match (physical attack, verbal attack, fight) means the player to be suspended until the end of the tournament.

2. The team's result is a walkover in the event of:

- when the team does not come to the match for no good reason,
- when the referees have to stop the match due to unforeseen events, such an event will be verified by the Main Referee + Tournament Organizer on the basis of the rules of the Polish Team of the People's Republic of Poland,

- lack of documents, i.e. a photo ID, ID card or passport confirming the identity of the players,

In the cases described above, the team automatically loses the match 0:10 (walkover).

All matches of a team for a given phase will be declared void if in that phase matches, the team will receive a walkover in at least 50% of scheduled matches.

In this case, each match is converted into a score of 10: 0 for the opposing team.

3. Protests. The referee's decisions on all matters relating to the game are final and binding; therefore, protests on these issues are not accepted. Any protests should be reported only by the appropriate team leader to the Tournament Organizer, not later than just after the match ends. The organizer, in consultation with the Main Referee, will make the appropriate decisions.

The Organizer's decision for each protest is final and binding.

VIII. Individual Trophies:

1. Top Goalscorer- the player who scores the most goals in the tournament. In the event that several players finish the competition with the same number of goals, the title is won by the player from the team with the highest ranking in the tournament.

2. Final MVP - a player who, according to the organizers, was chosen the best player of the match final. The award is for MVP's of each age category.

IX. Medical protection:

1. In each sports hall where the tournament will be held, the organizer provides at least one paramedic or a person trained to perform this function.

X. Summary

W kwestiach nie ujętych w regulaminie, spornych i innych sytuacjach decydują przepisy ZPRP, w innych sytuacjach nie ujętych w przepisach decyzję ostateczną podejmować będą Organizatorzy turnieju zgodnie z duchem gry i zasadami FAIR PLAY.

In matters not included in the regulations, disputes and other situations are decided by the provisions of the ZPRP (Polish Handball Association), in other situations not included in the regulations, the final decision will be made by the Tournament Organizers in accordance with the spirit of the game and the rules of FAIR PLAY.

The Tournament Organizer has the right to modify the match schedule of unexpected circumstances.

Tournament organizers are not responsible for damage, loss, theft of property or equipment of participants. They are also not responsible for any harm or injuries of the participants.
